




Rampant cases of animal bites, lack of rabies awareness






more chance of rabies in the area



Stray dogs as the main vectors of rabies




Puppies are left vulnerable to rabies


Virus spreads beyond barangay and even the City




Vaccination and public response is there, but not yet there

low castration turnout




1250 impounded dogs prevents 1 rabies case



















